




Virtual Farm Experiences

Leaping Lamb Farm, originally homesteaded in 1862, is a small family farm and farm stay located in a quiet creek valley of the Coast Range, Oregon. We are 40 miles from the ocean and 25 miles from the university town of Corvallis.









Covid hit early March and we cancelled all reservations through most of May



Bumped up social media so our guests wouldn't forget us.



We have limited quantities of pasture-raised meats for sale, as well as produce from the garden. Learn about our practices!



See how long it takes for anyone to notice there's a furry face in the crowd! We'll call in to your meeting.


30 minute Corporate Virtual Field Trip | \$250
